There being no other business, the meeting ended with the vote of thanks to the chair.













Minutes of Meeting of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of B. K. Birla College (Autonomous), Kalyan held on Saturday, the 26th August, 2022 at 2.00 p.m. in Conference room.

Prof. Maninder Kaur welcomed everyone for the meeting. Mrs. Lakshita Soni read the minutes of the previous meeting and sought for confirmation of the minutes. The members confirmed the minutes.

Dr. Naresh Chandra gave the opening address and reviewed the activities planned and conducted by various departments. Mr. O. R. Chitlange couldn't attend the meeting due to the previous engagements, but attended the meeting online. Second year and third year admission status were discussed and the gaps in the admission process were found out and cleared. The discussion regarding additional credits was initiated by Mr. Prakash with reference to SWAYAM courses undertaken by students and he also said the data of students completing the courses will be provided to BoE for reflecting their additional credits in the marksheet. Dr. Nareshchandra invited the members to contribute their ideas on International Visibility of the college. He also encouraged the members to apply for Major and Minor research projects. He stated that more Industrial -academia tie-ups need to take place.

Dr. Avinash Patil said that all departments must submit the Activities for the year (2022-23). BOS members must be finalized- CO, PO, PSO changes to be made in syllabus accordingly. He informed all the colleagues who have their CAS due must make the applications as soon as possible. He stated that grant allotted by Management per department is Rs. 25000/- for UG and Rs. 35000/- for PG. for conducting research, organizing Conferences, seminars, and workshops, etc. The department should plan the activity accordingly.

Ms. Lakshita Soni said that the mentor and mentee system should be documented with IQAC. She said that the quantitative matrix (Criteria 1) needs to be worked upon. She discussed that deadline to submit AQAR 2021-22 is in the month of February 2023. The formats of AAA will be given to all departments and then the consolidated report of the college will be sent. She mentioned that Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) data for 2022-23 first term to be collected as Google Forms and Schedule to be made for collection of data and its analysis which is required as per AQAR format.

The meeting ended on the note that Mr. O. R. Chitlange would be physically attending the meeting next time.

Mrs. Lakshita Soni welcomed the members present for the meeting. She read the minutes of the previous meeting and sought for confirmation of the minutes. The members confirmed the minutes.

Mr. O. R. Chitlange, Chairman, Governing Council chaired the meeting.

Mr. O. R. Chitlange started the meeting discussing about the challenges and changes in Higher Education Institutions. He presented 5 Quality Indicators for sustaining and enhancing the performance of college.

- 1) Enhancing Digital Footprints
- 2) Embracing Change
- 3) Cultural Shift in Teaching- Learning Process
- 4) Paperless College

5) Eco- Friendly and Sustainability initiatives

He highlighted the need for reinvention and the adoption of new strategies to combat the changes.

He mentioned that 'Change is inevitable', hence gaps should be analyzed, especially with reference to the digital world. He further said, we need to Rethink, Revisit and Relook our existing digital infrastructure to adapt to the new digital environment.

He also said that there is a cultural shift in teaching-learning processes and therefore as change agents, fast adoption is the need of the hour with respect to new subjects viz, Machine Intelligence, Artificial Intelligence, etc. Modernity in thoughts and actions is to be implemented.

He suggested the following principles viz. adequacy, clarity of concepts, authenticity, and commitment to keep pace with the change.

He emphasized the elimination of unnecessary paper consumption and moving towards paperless working.

He insisted on digital interactions and further added that pre-read documents should be circulated beforehand for timely approvals and sanctions.

He also contributed his thoughts towards the eco-friendly and sustainable developments in the college. He suggested we should reduce energy and water consumption by a minimum 5% initially. He acknowledged the installation of STP in the college premises as this initiation would bring desirable results.

Mr. O. R. Chitlange opened the meeting for members and requested to suggest measures for above concerned areas.

Mr. Bipinchandra Wadekar endorsed that a Cultural shift is required to connect better with new-age students and agreed that it is important to upgrade ourselves at regular intervals to be tech-savvy educators.

Mr. O. R. Chitlange informed that Training on new pedagogies will help to connect with the young generation and will aid to strengthen overall satisfaction of the students.

Mrs. Lakshita Soni proposed that 360⁰ Leadership Development Programs held in the year 2019-20 and 2020-21 were effective and hence to be continued. Mr. Chitlange endorsed and suggested preparing a concept note and showed his interest in attending some of the sessions.

Mr. B. D. Joshi suggested that LMS System which will facilitate learners' interest and give better access to study materials.

Mr. O. R. Chitlange emphasized that response to action needs vibrancy and hence suggested immediate measures to be taken. He suggested implementing delegation of work and empowerment for discharging duties and responsibilities.

Mr. Kiran Raikar explained that for ISO documentation, the team has created drive and all documents are uploaded there in the prescribed format. Further, he added that for college reaccreditation, we should create Department IDs and official information should be through Dept. ID.

Dr. Vinod Narayane said that Departmental audits should be taken for promoting paperless work culture.

Mr. O. R. Chitlange endorsed and said that an internal audit by the department should be done. He also emphasized that companies are going on online mode. Remote Learning in the future will be another change. BITS has programs that are on online mode, multiple courses, and networking all is done online. A digital wall can be replicated in the College also.

Mrs. Soumya Majumdar briefed about the placement activity in the College. 128 placement drives have been organized and 300 students are placed till date. She mentioned that at college level, we must work towards enhancing the communication skills of the students and also to improve the content knowledge of the students. She proposed to allocate a dedicated room for organizing training programs for the students to train students on softskills.

Mr. O. R. Chitlange approved and suggested that Training room can be allotted in the new Building.

Mrs. Esmita Gupta suggested that we should also have a Group Discussion room with a planned schedule to improve the confidence and communication skills of the students.

Prof. Maninder Dhaliwal suggested that concession in placement fees should be considered for needy students. Mr. O. R. Chitlange replied that if the matter is genuine, the same can be refundable if needed.

Mrs. Soumya Majumdar requested all the Head of the Departments that every student who is placed or has received an internship via cell or any of the department faculty must be reported to the Placement Cell as while filling the data we need to also fill in the data of those students who are placed off campus.

Mr. O. R. Chitlange suggested that publicity and department support for placement is required, and all efforts should be made by the college authorities to strengthen placement and training activities.

Dr. Naresh Chandra said that college has already launched one online program for PGDGE,

and expressed that college is planning to start PG Diploma in Artificial Intelligence which will also be 100% online. He also briefed about the preliminary discussions initiated by the college for the implementation of NEP 2020 from next academic year.

As there was no other business, the meeting was concluded with Vote of thanks to the Chair.













Minutes of Meeting of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of B. K. Birla College (Autonomous), Kalyan held on Saturday, the 28th April, 2023 at 10.00 a.m. in Seminar Hall.

Mrs. Lakshita Soni welcomed everyone for the meeting. She read the minutes of the previous meeting and sought for confirmation of the minutes. The members confirmed the minutes.

Ms. Lakshita Soni welcomed Mr. O. R. Chitlange, Mr. Subodh Dave, IQAC members and all the Heads of Department for the meeting. She read out the agenda of the meeting.

Chairman Mr. O. R. Chitlange addressed the gathering by first congratulating everyone as our college is figured in the top 10 institutions in the country.

He spoke about perceptions, and how they matter. Perceptions or looking towards any matter, are different for different people. He asked if we are eligible for excelling and enhancing.

He suggested we rename the IQAC calling it IQEC- Internal Quality Enhancement Cell. We need to continuously evolve ourselves to excel. We need to do our homework well, understand the relevance – present and futures – to be through and change/ evolve.

The resources, i.e. the faculty need to be thought of and need to be revived. We need to be a responsible organization.

He spoke about the five ‘E’s

1. Enthusiasm – to explore, to improve our ability with total enthusiasm.
2. Enrichment- Enhancement is possible through enrichment. Boldness helps to be proper, and to give shape to the company. We are responsible for

making footprints. Trust needs to be demonstrated; we need to encourage other ourselves and others to be better.

3. Encouragement- to the faculty, support staff, authorities.
4. Enlist- in new age programs. New programs to enrich knowledge should be studied. We should be flexible, should show desire to learn new things. Coaching (personal or entire faculty) should be provided. Enlist to break the barriers within and learn new things to enrich our minds and bodies. He requested all the enlist in new programs and break the barrier of comfort.
5. Enrichment-We must take risks. There is a need for transformation and evolution. We need to go through potential assessment programs. We need to improvise.

Presentations were carried out Vice principal Dr. Mahadev Yadav on 'Vision and way forward for faculty of Arts' highlighting the best practices adopted by various departments.

Mr. O. R. Chitlange requested to make a list of seminars and conferences to be organized in the academic year 2023-24. He asked to freeze the dates and make the budget required for the same.

Presentation by Vice principal Dr. Maninderkaur Dhaliwal on 'Implementation of NEP 2020 in Faculty of Science'. She also spoke about training requirements and way forward. She also presented on the advancements in the curriculum.

Mr. O. R. Chitlange asked about the Major and Minor courses of credit distribution. He asked about the Open Elective and which students will be able to take OE course. Dr. Maninderkaur Dhaliwal explained about the credit system and spoke about the Basket of OE which will be offered to all students.

Mr. O. R. Chitlange asked if any extra infrastructure would be required and to make out a list of details required.

Mr. O. R. Chitlange talked about implementing individual budgets for the faculty members which would be used for personal growth, training requirements. He requested a detailed requirement list and budget keeping the NEP revision in mind. He suggested that the Commerce faculty meet with the Chamber of Commerce for further help and upgradation in the new syllabus.

Mr. O. R. Chitlange asked for a training calendar based on individual faculty member. Also asked about individual budget requirements.

Ms. Lakshita Soni briefed about the SSR documentation. She explained that SSR needs to be studied thoroughly criterion-wise. Question/ Information sought in SSR that is not a part of AQAR needs to be identified and highlighted. Criterion-wise submission and compilation of modifications has to be initiated by May 2023.

Director Naresh Chandra informed about the Academic Council meeting held on 27th April 2022, where the latest GR for the implementation of NEP 2020 was acknowledged and passed. He informed the chairman that all the departments will be working on the changes in the syllabus based on the GR.
