Feedback on Curriculum Received from Students, Alumni, Parents and Faculties

Sr. No.	Feedback	Action Taken and its overall impact
1.	The students suggested that the Certificate courses maybe organized in relative topics. A few students mentioned that the Dept. should provide guidance on civil services exams like UPSC/MPS and should provide students a platform to showcase their creativity and organizational skills.	The Dept. had conducted Certificate Course in Indian History for Competitive Exams and Certificate Course in Brahmi Script. Dept. had organized an exhibition under the title of SHIVARAYANGAN. This helped to develop career oriented learning amongst the students and contributed to the employability skills and creativity of the students.
2.	The Parents encourage the students to study more in their understanding of subject or interesting topics. Also, the parents asked to keep a watch on punctuality and attendance of students in classroom and guide students on Career opportunities.	The students were informed about SWAYAM initiatives and provided information on SWAYAM NPTEL online courses. The Dept. had been vigilant on attendance of students and parents of defaulters were informed accordingly. The Dept. had organized lecture on Career Guidance lecture for the students. Thus, students became more job oriented.


