

Day 1: Workshop on Mehndi (05/10/23)

The workshop was organized exclusively for learning a traditional art of Mehndi. Miss Meghna Shah guided the students on how to draw various types of Mehndi. Madam started her session from how to prepare Mehndi at home. She also showed various Mehndi designs



and tricks to make mehndi on various styles in faster way. She also guided on what to do and what to not do while drawing mehndi.

This was learning and fun activity for all the students. Students enjoyed the workshop, by learning activity very well. Girls tried to draw nice mehndi on each other hands.

Day 2: Workshop on Artificial Jewelry making (06/10/23)

During the workshop the participants understood the art of jewelry making by using various materials. Emphasis was given on using waste material and creating jewelry out of it. Participants enjoyed the workshop and promised to make more artifacts for upcoming exhibition cum sell.







He advised not to visit unknown websites and download of images. He asked the students to check sharing options on their smart devices. In the question answer session, he cleared various doubts of students.

The next special talk on 'Legal Awareness for Women' was delivered by Adv. Prajakta Deshpande (High Court Mumbai). Madam discussed various laws instituted by Indian Constitution for preserving and helping women's rights. She discussed different cases in which



constitution and law has helped women to seek justice. An awareness was created about POSCO Act and Disha Act by the speaker. Madam encouraged students to come forward and advised them to be aware of what is going on in the society and in our surrounding. She motivated girls and told them to show courage and be vocal about any problem related to women.

A total of 79 girl students participated and benefited by the seminar.




