

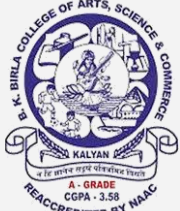

• Rules and regulations for competitions:

1. To participate in the competition kindly register using the link.
2. For every competition two winners will be selected by the panel of experts and e-certificates will be provided to all the winners and all participants.
3. The judges' decision is final.

• Nature photography (On Birla College campus only)

1. The photograph should be clicked by the candidate on campus using the Android mobile.
2. The photograph should be geotagged.
3. Do not use any photograph published in any magazine or on any other media.
4. Photo editing is not allowed.
5. Only one photograph per participant.
6. Individual competition.

• 'Word it all' – Story Writing Competition (Open for Faculty and Students)

1. Ensure that your story revolves around any theme related to birds.
2. Create a unique and original story.
3. Use correct grammar and punctuation.
4. Word limit 3000.
5. Only one story can be submitted by each participant.
6. Selected stories could be published in a book bearing ISBN.
7. Individual competition.

• Competition : Make a Innovative Bird Feeder:

1. Ensure that all bird feeders created, adhere to a specific theme or concept.
2. Use waste material such as soft drink bottles, empty water bottles, etc.
3. Bird feeders should not contain any sharp edges, toxic materials, or other potential hazards for birds or humans.
4. Bird feeders should effectively dispense food and attract birds. They should be designed to accommodate different bird species and be easily refillable.
5. Plagiarism or copying existing designs will be rejected.
6. Individual competition.

• Greeting Card Making Competition (Sketch/painting on birds)

1. Time allotted: 90 Minutes.
2. Size – Half A-4 Sheet.
2. The Painting should be original.
3. The participants should carry their own Drawing sheet, water bottle, drawing and painting material, and rough cloth for cleaning.
4. Evaluation will be based on the theme, quality, its artistic value and overall presentation.
5. Individual competition.

• Rangoli Competition on the theme of bird conservation

1. Participants should create rangolis that feature birds, habitat etc.
2. Traditional rangoli materials may include colored powders, rice husk, flower petals, and colored sand can be used.
3. Areas for making rangoli will be 1 meter X 1 meter
4. Maximum two students in one group.

• Rules and regulations for competitions:

• Elocution Competition

- **Topic of Elocution .** 'The Role of Birds in Ecosystems' or 'Famous Birds in Literature and Mythology'.
- Duration for an individual speech can range from 3 to 5 minutes.
- Individual participation.
