

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Entry would be on a first come first serve basis.
- All the students coming to the event need to carry a valid college ID proof for entry (Current academic year).
- All participating colleges need to be represented by one Contingent Leader (CL) and one Assistant Contingent Leader (ACL).
- Participants are not allowed to wear their college IDs or college t-shirts on the day of the events.
- Only authorized people from the organizing committee will be allowed to handle equipment. No unauthorized person will be allowed backstage.
- CL, ACL and participation need to get registered on the day of the fest at the registration desk.
- All situational issues would be handled solely at the discretion of the events team.

- List of props, equipment and materials to be submitted a day before the event.
- Any kind of vulgarity, profanity, obscenity or disrespect in any form will lead to disqualification.
- The organizing committee will not be responsible for any technical issues from the participant's end.
- A pen drive or a file consisting of only 1 track should be submitted at the re - registration desk for the respective event in .mp3 format and should be name as the event name and college code.
