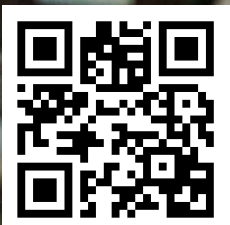
METAMORPHOSIS '23

Event 2: Escape Room(11AM)

Event 4: Quizadry(1PM)

- Duration: 10 minutes for 20 mcqs.

- Story can be self- composed or written by another author.

Event 6: War of Facts(Debate)(11AM)

- Groups will be created randomly.
- A random topic will be chosen for each group.
- 10 minutes for discussion.
- Two rounds for each group (7 minutes per round)

Event 7: Book Review(12PM)

- Select any book/Novel from the given options.
- Participant has to submit the written book review on the day of the event.
- Each participant will be allotted 7-10 minutes for their presentation .
- Books- Tomb of sand,Celestial Bodies,The white tiger,The kite runner, The Buried Giant, Blindness , The Tunnel, Less.
