

FAQs for BAMMC

Is the institute Government or Private?

Our Institute is affiliated to the University of Mumbai and has 'Empowered Autonomous Status'.

What is the duration of the program?

This is a three -year undergraduate full-time program.

How to apply for admissions?

The student has to first register his credentials with the University of Mumbai through its official website (<https://mumoa.digitaluniversity.ac/>) and select '**B. K. Birla College (Autonomous)**' **code 23** along with the course for which he/she is interested. The student will also fill in the admission form through the college website (<https://bkbck.edu.in/>) for completing the process of applying for admissions.

Both Form portal filling process is necessary.

Is there a need to appear for any entrance examination?

No.

What are the admission criteria? Will there be any provisions for In-House Students?

Since this is a professional course, admissions will be awarded strictly based on Merit. There is **no separate provision for in-house students for Unaided Programs.** (Refer Admission Notice for Outside Students (2025-26) and Admission Notice for Unaided Courses (2025-26) on College Website).

What is the maximum intake and reservation scheme?

The Intake capacity is 60 students per division for BAMMC and the reservation scheme is as per the rules framed by the Government of Maharashtra.

What will be the admission schedule?

The admission schedule will be as per the guidelines provided by the University of Mumbai.

What is the fee structure?

Is a hostel facility provided by the college?

Is attendance of classes compulsory?

Yes, the candidate is expected to maintain a minimum of 75% attendance as per the guidelines (*Ordinance No. 0.6086*) issued by the University of Mumbai.

Yes, the college does have a placement cell that provides placement assistance by organizing training sessions, conducting placement drives, and encouraging students for Internships.

Are there any projects or practical work conducted?
